LCYC CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

The LCYC code of conduct exists to ensure the safety of the youth first and foremost. The staff and volunteers all strive to make LCYC an inclusive, safe and fun environment for everyone. To be simple our code of conduct is RESPECT YOURSELF, OTHERS and the PROPERTY.

Signing In/Signing Out

All youth must sign in when they arrive and sign out when they leave. If you leave the centre after 7pm you will NOT be allowed back in that night. On Wednesdays, Thursdays & Fridays you are allowed to leave only once before 7pm.

The signing out of items such as: gaming consoles, ping pong table, air hockey, foose ball, pool table and computers require a deposit of a shoe. If there is a line up for an item, there is a 30 minute maximum sign out time. If item is not returned in regular condition youth may lose sign out privileges and face further consequence.

Three warnings and you are asked to leave

We want to create and maintain an atmosphere of safety for youth. Hence, we follow a three warning system, where a youth will be given three warnings to correct his/her behavior according to the rules listed below; if such action continue, the youth will be asked to leave the Centre for the night (or longer based on staff decision). Staff and volunteers retain the right to ask youth to leave without three warnings.

Language

All language should be inclusive and appropriate for everyone at LCYC. We ask that youth do not call each other down. If caught swearing or using inappropriate language the "three warnings and you are out" rule will apply.

Public Display of Affection

Youth and leaders are uncomfortable if others are intruding on his/her personal space. The following is not permitted: laying down on another youth, groping, kissing, sitting down on another youth, etc. Staff & volunteers have the right to make the judgement call on this matter and issue warnings.

Food/Drinks Policy

LCYC provides youth with a concession that includes chocolate bars, pop, candy, frozen treats, chips, and healthy alternatives. Energy drinks are not permitted in LCYC.

Tobacco & Vaporizers

Youth need to sign out to take a smoke break. Youth are required to smoke off property. There is a zero tolerance for tobacco use and vaporizing on property, youth who smoke or use vaporizers on property will receive consequences.

Drugs/Alcohol

Any and all alcohol/drugs are not permitted for use in or on the premise of the Lloydminster Community Youth Centre. If youth have possession and/or are suspected to be intoxicated staff and volunteers have the right to ask him/her to leave.

Fighting/Bullying/Aggressive Behavior

Pushing, shoving, aggressive behavior and calling someone on will not be tolerated. One warning will be given and if the behavior continues they will be asked to leave. Youth involved in serious fights will be asked for leave for a minimum of one week. We will keep a formal record of the incident.

Weapons

There is zero tolerance for an obvious use of a weapon, either threatening or attempt to use. If necessary, the police will be contacted to deal with the situation.

Dress Code

Staff and volunteers reserve the right to ask youth to remove/add clothing when it does not meet the LCYC Dress Code. We have a detailed list of our dress code for a reference point.

LCYC Van

We ask that you wear your seat belt and remain respectful in the van. If leaders are seeing misconduct in van there will be consequences
